Also, the 'Swachh Bharat Abhiyaan' is an integral part of the college for the cleanliness of the campus.

5. Evidence of Success


The waste boxes, the drainage system and the task of the Department of Chemistry widely speaks a loud about the success of making the institution clean. The trees are planted, particularly on the World Environment Day. In the process of cleaning, particularly making "tobacco free" and "Plastic free" zone, the main source of the institution is its own students.
